Introductions	Current Board Members Jason Gram, Cory Reynolds, and Judith Milstein, and HOA Manager Dennis Howard were introduced.
Snoqualmie and North Bend Chief of Police – Steven McCulley	Steven McCulley spoke to Homeowners about his department and the reasons for the transition from King County. McCulley emphasized all the resources available to his department. McCulley discussed his approach to curbing criminal activity and camping by the homeless population. There was a question and answer period. McCulley encouraged people not to hesitate to call 911 with concerns and emergencies. The business line is 425-888-3333. Budget Report	Dennis explained the landscaping spending increase for 2013 due to the removal of some old and potentially dangerous trees. Attorney fees also increased due to the legal action taken against a homeowner. HOA Board discussed the importance of completing the lower park project as quickly as possible as so much is tied up in the bond for the City of North Bend. The Board plans to tackle some of the Reserve Study items as the bond money is returned.

Projects Planned	Lower Park Project – Permits have been obtained to complete the lower park project this summer. The city required bond will seriously deplete our reserves. The Board still intends to avoid a special assessment barring any emergencies.
Notice of Board Vacancy	Jason Gram re-elected by the homeowners to continue serving as President. Jason Gram approved, seconded, all in favor, none against.
